Introducing TOUCHLOCK

TOUCHLOCK keypads give you control over who has access to your building.

Keys also do this - so what is the difference?

When you lose a key, you have the expense and inconvenience of replacing locks and all the other keys, or you accept that your building is no longer secure.

TOUCHLOCK access control systems allow you to change the code. There is no need to replace any locks or 'keys'.

TOUCHLOCK stops unauthorised persons 'wandering in' to a building or secure area.

TOUCHLOCK systems are maintenance free.

This booklet explains how this works.





TOUCHLOCK K series keypads

- ▼ Users enter a code to gain entry
- ▼ Codes can be changed quickly by the system administrator
- ▼ Simple programming using the keypad
- ▼ Codes may be between 4 and 8 digits long

Available in 5 colours. Bezels can be replaced periodically for that brand new look.

3 sizes for different environments and applications. 38mm, 50mm and 75mm wide.
